

Home Group Leader

Job Description



The Home Group Leader is responsible for creating the best possible environment so that members of the group experience significant personal spiritual growth, encouragement and fellowship.

1. **Your Walk** - Maintain a strong personal relationship with God through daily personal Bible study and prayer.
2. **Bible Study** - Lead group members to discover and apply the truths of God's Word to life, using effective small group methods and encouraging members to participate in learning exercises.
3. **Fellowship** - Lead group members to build supportive relationships with one another, both inside and outside of group meetings.
4. **Prayer** - Lead group members to pray for one other's needs and for the church.
5. **Mission Projects** - Lead the group to participate collectively and individually in mission events and partnerships. Seek an ongoing relationship with a group that needs hands-on work.
6. **Leadership** - Enlist others in the group to use their spiritual gifts in taking responsibility for the successful work and ministry of the group.
7. **Communication** - Support the overall work of the small groups ministry and the church, facilitating the flow of information and materials to and from class members.
8. **Team Ministry** - Participate in leadership training and coordination events sponsored by the church. If this is not possible, have a representative from your group present at the meeting.
9. **Accountability** - The Home Group Leader is responsible for the effectiveness of the group and is accountable to the following: a Home Group Coach, the Home Group Ministry Director and/or the Pastor of Small Groups.
