- <u>The Job</u>. I will fulfill the tasks outlined in my job description and support the mission and strategy of the church.

 Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others..." (1 Peter 4:10)
- <u>Church Involvement.</u> I will actively participate worship, group life and service opportunities through the church. "Let us not give up meeting together... but let us encourage one another..." (Heb 10:25 NIV)
- <u>Spiritual Growth</u>. I will pursue spiritual growth by practicing the daily habits of personal Bible reading and prayer. "Pray continually" (1 Th 5:17) "I will not neglect your word." (Psa 119:16)
- <u>Public Witness.</u> I will live a morally pure life, and refrain from any activity that could cause a brother to stumble.

- My Spouse. I will secure the permission of my spouse (if applicable) to serve in this leadership role.
