What is Bible Study?


You may have grown up calling it Sunday School, but we call it Bible Study to keep the Bible as the main focus of this ministry. The Bible is God's inspired word, and in it God reveals Himself to man. It is the basis of who we are, what we believe, and what we practice. Therefore, we should devote ourselves to learn from it and do what it says (James 1:22)

Also, our small-group Bible Study Classes are the heart of Westwood. It's where we get to know one another, build strong relationships with other believers, and join together to do the ministry of the church.

Hebrews 10:25 tells us to "not forsake the assembling of ourselves together". Looking at the context of the verse, we see that the purpose is for our encouragement. The best place to do that in the church is through our Bible Study Ministry. Here's why:

- 1. You see the same group of people every week.
- 2. You can share prayer concerns in your life with others who care.
- 3. You study God's Word together and apply it to life.
- 4. The people you meet with are in the same life-stage.
- 5. A system is in place for care and ministry.
- 6. They will miss you if you're not there.
- 7. It provides a place for you to build relationships and invest in the lives of others.

We shouldn't just see Sunday morning Bible Study as just another ministry of the church. It is the organizational backbone of the church. Because it is the only ministry in the church for every age group, we will use it more and more in the future as the point of contact for ministry and mission opportunities the church will seek to accomplish.
