## Home Group Leader



The Home Group Leader is responsible for creating the best possible environment so that members of the group experience significant personal spiritual growth, encouragement and fellowship.

- 1. Your Walk Maintain a strong personal relationship with God through daily personal Bible study and prayer.
- 2. <u>Bible Study</u> Lead group members to discover and apply the truths of God's Word to life, using effective small group methods and encouraging members to participate in learning exercises.
- 3. <u>Fellowship</u> Lead group members to build supportive relationships with one another, both inside and outside of group meetings.
- 4. **Prayer** Lead group members to pray for one other's needs and for the church.
- 5. <u>Mission Projects</u> Lead the group to participate collectively and individually in mission events and partnerships. Seek an ongoing relationship with a group that needs hands-on work.
- 6. <u>Leadership</u> Enlist others in the group to use their spiritual gifts in taking responsibility for the successful work and ministry of the group.
- 7. <u>Communication</u> Support the overall work of the small groups ministry and the church, facilitating the flow of information and materials to and from class members.
- 8. <u>Team Ministry</u> Participate in leadership training and coordination events sponsored by the church. If this is not possible, have a representative from your group present at the meeting.
- <u>Accountability</u> The Home Group Leader is responsible for the effectiveness of the group and is accountable to the following: a Home Group Coach, the Home Group Ministry Director and/or the Pastor of Small Groups.
