Mission Statement

Westwood's Home Group Ministry exists to develop growing disciples by:

- a) experiencing community and life-on-life spiritual encouragement.
- b) living on mission together.
- c) encouraging spiritual growth through the practice of spiritual disciplines.
- d) developing leaders in order to multiply groups.



Organization and Strategy:

- 1. Groups meet weekly for Bible study, fellowship, and prayer.
- 2. Group size will be at least eight, but no more than 15 people. Twelve is the ideal number.
- 3. Groups will meet year-round, breaking no more than two weeks at any time.
- 4. The Group Leader will intentionally shepherd the group to fulfill its mission.
- 5. Leaders will enlist an apprentice and other leaders to coordinate various aspects of group life.
- 6. Groups will seek to provide leadership and sponsor a new group every two years.
- 7. Groups will function on a semester system:
 - a. New members may enter the group in August and January if space is available.
 - b. Existing members will re-enlist or opt-out at the end of each semester.
 - c. Groups with existing space will be open for new members during the semester.
 - d. During the open enrollment month, new group members will sign up online.*
- 8. All of Westwood's groups will at times participate in coordinated church-wide studies.
- 9. Group members will agree to abide by Westwood's Group Covenant.
- 10. Groups will be assigned a coach who will be a mentor and helper.
- 11. Groups passing 12-15 in attendance need to sponsor a new group.
- 12. The church will organize service, ministry and missions through its small groups.
- 13. Each meeting's attendance will be reported by the group.
- 14. Group leaders experiencing challenges are expected to discuss issues with their coach, Campus Pastor and/or the Small Groups Pastor.
