

Small Group Leadership Position

Missions Coordinator

“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations...” Matthew 28:18

The ULTIMATE PURPOSE of Small Groups is to grow disciples IN ORDER TO take the Gospel to “the ends of the earth”. This is perfectly in line with Westwood’s vision statement “Reach People. Make Disciples.” However, this may (and likely will) tactically look different for each small group. God does not lead every person to reach the same people in the same way. He has given all of us different spheres of influence and different passions/convictions for certain areas of ministry or people.

The primary role of this person is to help the group practically engage in missions, both local and international.

NOTE: This position can be divided into a Local Mission Coordinator and a Foreign Mission Coordinator.

Below are the areas of responsibility for this leadership role:

- Serve as the primary contact for the group for all Missions related events, needs, etc. for the church.
- Become familiar with the church’s Mission Partners both locally and foreign.
- Selects missionaries or mission partners for the group to pray for on a weekly basis
- Helps the group select a local partner or local mission to engage in
 - Serve as the primary contact for the groups efforts
 - Coordinates all logistics related to engaging in local mission efforts
- Help the group select a foreign partner or missionary to partner with.
 - Serve as the primary contact for this mission partner
 - Be aware of their needs, prayer requests, etc.
- If the group selects a foreign mission trip to participate in, this person will serve as the group’s primary contact for all logistical issues and concerns
